
Length of the public transport network – 1 589 km

- Real-time information for passengers










Public transport modal split (2013)

Line 2 - 10,8 km with 11 stations

In April 2015 two new sections with a total length of 10 km and 7 stations will be put in operation, including the connection to Sofia Airport.










General scheme for the development of the metro

Renewal of the public transport fleet

Implementation of activities for improvement of air quality by purchase and delivery of:

- 20 low-floor trams
- 10 new metro trains
- 126 low-floor CNG buses

Sofia Integrated Urban Transport Project:

- Delivery of 50 new articulated low-floor trolleybuses

Electric bus – pilot project

















The bus uses ultra capacitor – charging faster than usual batteries.

The charging takes about 7 minutes, which is enough for a 30 km run.

Max.speed - 80 km/h.

Capacity - 90 passengers (32 seats).

The bus operates on trolleybus line 11.

Charging at the final stops on the route.



ITS equipment for 20 intersections ITS equipment in 750 vehicles Construction works at 7 intersections











Short-term paid parking zones

Construction of surface and underground car parks to increase the capacity for parking

Park&Ride at metro stations











Short-term paid parking zones

Reducing the traffic in the city centre by introducing short-term paid parking zones

"BLUE ZONE" about 5,000 parking spaces

Maximum duration of time for parking – up to 2 hours.

Price – 2.00 BGN per hour Mon-Fr: 08.00 - 19.00 h.

Sat: 08.00 - 14.00 h.

"GREEN ZONE" about 11,000 parking spaces

Maximum duration of time for parking – up to 4 hours.

Price – 1.00 BGN per hour Mon-Fr: 08.00 - 19.00 h.



Electric vehicles can park in short-term parking zones for free.

35 km cycling network
 Transit routes
 Feeding routes
 Routes for recreation and leisure

- 1% active cyclists
- The planned length of cycling network until the end of 2015 is 66 km.

















Strategic Framework for Cycling

- Master Plan for Traffic Organization of Sofia Municipality
- Programme for development of cycling in Sofia
- Development Plan for Cycling in Sofia
- Establishment of working groups with participation of NGOs

















5. Rail4See added value for improving mobility management policies of Sofia municipality

Tariff integration between urban transport and railways

The Master Plan of Sofia Municipality shows insignificant use of the railways for urban trips - 10 000 trips per day /less than 1% of the total urban transport trips/.

Steps for the implementation of integrated transport documents:

- 1. Preliminary actions:
- Coordination at the political level the institutions of central and local government
- Coordination and coherence with PT operators
- 2. Possible stages of introducing integrated tariffs:
- Mutual recognition of tickets for the same route
- Mutual recognition of tickets within the network
- Integrated tariffs
